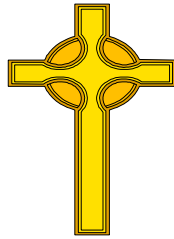

Dear Parents,

As you know we have been trialling the 'Monster Point' behaviour system. This has proved to be popular and effective for the majority of our pupils. We would like to make the system as clear and consistent as possible for you and the children

In school, children are rewarded for good choices with Monster Points and Monster Point Stickers. At the end of each half term, children who have earned 50 or more points will be rewarded with a treat activity session during the last week, which is planned by their class teacher.

**Any children who have not earned 50 points will NOT be entitled to take part in this reward and will do work as usual.**

For bad choices, children will lose Monster Points, with additional consequences as outlined on the 'Ladder of Consequences' on the back of this letter.

We recognise that for some pupils a more individual approach may be needed. In such cases, an Individual Behaviour Plan will be drawn up with parent/carer, class teacher and SENCO.
