

These webinars aim to not be like any training you have attended before and to challenge a lot of how autism is typically described.

The 6 sessions are taking place on Thursdays, 7-9pm:

- **2** 3rd October: Understanding the wider autism lens
- 2 10th October: Autism from our perspective (delivered by autistic young people)
- I7th October: Autism and trauma
- 24th October: Supporting young people with meltdowns
- 2 31st October: A deep dive into motivation and 'behaviour'
- 2 7th November: Understanding anxiety and wellbeing
