








Reception Summer Curriculum

	<p>We will be learning about the themes 'Good News', 'Friends' and 'Our World'. Children will come to understand that everyone has good news to share, that we all have a friendship with Jesus and about God's wonderful world. All teachings will reflect our Catholic ethos. Children will also take part in daily collective worship.</p>
	<p>Children will be developing their mathematical vocabulary through describing the everyday shapes (such as tall, curved, round) and will name 2D shapes, including those in the environment. In number, we will be deepening our understanding of number and partitioning.</p>
	<p>Communication and Language: Reception will be further developing story narrative, skills in rhyming words and listening skills through recalling what they have heard. Literacy: Through stories such as 'The Gingerbread Man', 'The 3 Billy Goats Gruff', 'Mister Seahorse', 'The Snail and the Whale', 'The Lighthouse Keeper' and 'A House for Hermit Crab', children will develop skills in sequencing events in the correct order and discussing key events, characters and settings. In our Read Write Inc Phonics we will continue to identify sounds and learning how to represent these sounds through writing.</p>
	<p>This term, we will be investigating the topics; 'water' and 'materials'. We will be taking part in science experiments and recording and comparing our findings.</p>
	<p>Reception will continue to follow the 'PATHS' programme, learning to recognise the different emotions we feel. We will practise doing 'the turtle', which we learned about at the end of Spring term. This helps us to calm down when we feel angry or mad.</p>
	<p>Reception will be developing skills creating props to support role-play and using colours for a particular purpose. We will also be acting out stories through role-play.</p>
	<p>Reception will be looking at their speed and agility in Summer term. We will also be discovering new ways in which to travel and learning some more gymnastics.</p>
